TO OUR BELOVED FAITHFUL IN CHRIST OF THE DIOCESE OF MANCHESTER

In observance with the norms of law governing the Universal Church regarding the Jubilee Year of Hope and the imparting of the Apostolic Blessing and the granting of the Plenary Indulgence for the remission of temporal punishment due to sin,

DECREE and PROMULGATE

the Jubilee Year as directed by His Holiness Francis, Pope of Rome to be in effect in the Diocese of Manchester as of Vespers on December 28, 2024 until Vespers on December 29, 2025.

Of particular law of the Diocese of Manchester,

the Plenary Indulgence and Apostolic Blessing

are to be granted to those who, fulfilling the norms established for reception of the Indulgence (Sacramental confession and renunciation of sin, reception of Holy Communion, prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father and acts of charity)

participate in some way (joining in part of the procession, or adoring the Most Blessed Sacrament as the procession passes by, or prayerfully attending an observance at a processional stopping point)

in the Diocesan Eucharistic Pilgrimage

to be held beginning on Sunday May 18, 2025 and concluding its statewide travel on Thursday June 19, 2025.
